2018 Summer Fish Stocking

The Chautauqua County Soil & Water Conservation District is now taking orders for the summer fish stocking. **Delivery will be in Late-June (tentatively June 29th) at the Frank W Bratt Agricultural Center, 3542 Turner Road, Jamestown, NY.** A letter will be sent confirming the delivery date, time and transportation instructions.

Recommended stocking rates are 25 Bass, 25 Channel Catfish, and/or 25 perch per ¼ acre of pond surface area. A minimum order for each species is 25 except Koi.

If you are interested in stocking your pond with any of these fish, please fill out the order form below. Return completed order form to the Chautauqua County SWCD at 220 Fluvanna Ave, Suite 600, Jamestown, NY 14701, no later than June 22nd, with check made payable to Chautauqua County SWCD.

All orders must be received in our office by June 22nd.
