CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY ENVIROTHON RULES

2024

 Envirothon will cover five major topics: Soils, Wildlife, Aquatics, Forestry and a Current Issue ("Renewable Energy for a Sustainable Future" for 2024).

 The winning team is the team with the highest cumulative total points based on all of the topic stations.

 Any student who has, or will, participate in any other county's local or regional Envirothon, may not participate in the Chautauqua County Envirothon in the same calendar year.

•Each school may enter up to 2 teams, consisting of no more than 5 members per team.

•Team members must be enrolled in grade levels 9 through 12.

 Team may bring 2 alternates per registered team. These alternates must be listed on the team registration, but are not able to participate in the test taking.

 Any team member may be replaced by the alternate at any time prior to the start of the competition, but no substitutions will be allowed after the competition begins.

•The competition will take place RAIN or SHINE! All participants should dress appropriately.

•No Envirothon judge will be allowed to help a team prepare for the event, except for at the review session.
