## 2021 Spring Fish Stocking Sale

The Chautauqua County Soil & Water Conservation District is now taking orders for the spring fish stocking sale. **Order distribution is anticipated to take place the third or fourth week of May at the Frank W Bratt Agricultural Center located at 3542 Turner Road in Jamestown, New York.** All who make a purchase will receive a sales receipt, curbside pick-up instructions and fish transportation instructions via USPS mail prior to pick-up. Set COVID-19 safety measures will be in place to minimize personal contact at fish distribution.

Recommended stocking rates are 25 Channel Catfish, 25 Largemouth Bass and/or 25 Perch per 1/4 to 1/2 acre of pond surface area. **The minimum order for game fish is 25. Please note that there are limited quantities of Largemouth Bass and Perch available.**

Please fill out the order form below and return it by mail to **Chautauqua County SWCD at 220 Fluvanna Ave, Suite 600, Jamestown, NY 14701**, with your credit card information or a check made payable to Chautauqua County SWCD. **You do not need to provide a copy of your Farm Fishpond License. However, if you are ordering Triploid Grass Carp, please return all three original copies of your grass carp permit with your order form. You will receive a completed copy of your grass carp permit when you pick up your order.**

**All orders must be received in our office by Monday, May 10, 2021.**

## How to Obtain Fish for Your Pond

The Farm Fishpond License allows the licensee, their immediate family, and their employees to take fish at any time, in any size, in any number, and in any manner as stipulated in their individual license. The Farm Fishpond License also serves as a stocking permit, eliminating the need to obtain a separate Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) fish stocking permit which is required to stock fish into any waters of the state. The Farm Fishpond License is free and is good for five years. You can download an application from our website at: <http://soilwater.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/06/Farm-Fish-Pond-Application.pdf>. To stock grass carp in a pond in the State of New York you must apply for a Grass Carp Permit from the DEC. You can download an application from our website at: <http://soilwater.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/06/grasscarppermitappl.pdf>. Additional information about grass carp permits can be found by visiting the DEC's website at <https://www.dec.ny.gov/permits/25024.html>. To apply for the permit, you will need to know the size of your pond in acres, depths, fish species, water sources, and identify the plant species in the pond. Ideally, aquatic weeds should be identified in the summer months when weed densities are high. **When the application has been completed it must be returned to the DEC for processing.** The DEC will determine the maximum number of grass carp that can be stocked into your pond from the information provided on the application form.
